To the Honorable Commissioners Court of  
Tulsa County:  
The undersigned Jurors acting under the order of this court made on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Aug. 1912 after being duly sworn did on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Jan. 2<sup>d</sup> 1913 proceed to lay out and survey said road beginning at  
and terminating at  
and at the same time proceeded to assess the damages material to the opening of said road after having given notice to the land owners through whose land said road runs the field notes of said survey and also a copy of said road map as follows:  
Beginning at a point known as F. R. French's Mill lying about 5 miles S. of Mt. Pleasant, Tex.  
Thence West to French's Mill line and Byrd's E. B. line a distance of 854 feet Thence N with Byrd's E. B. line 1900 feet Byrd's N. E. cor. Thence N with Byrd's N. D. line passing his NW cor. in all W. 4665 ft. Thence N 1100 feet Thence W 1200 feet intersecting the Mt. Pleasant & Putnam road.

Horton et al for a change in the Public Road leading Claude Scotts Place as a to run on land line between Claude Scotts and Tomsoy's N.E. cor changing the bearings of said road from a S.W. direction angling across the tract of land owned by E.H. Horton and change said road so that said road will follow the land line <sup>partly</sup> that the lower Mt. Pleasant and also road lower Claude Scotts S.W. line to the N.E. cor of Pettigrew's land and thence due S. with Pettigrew's E.B. line till you reach the N.E. cor of Tomsoy's land and the S.E. cor of Pettigrew's land and into the said also Road again
