

July Term 1913 July 14th

Be it remembered that on this the 14th day of July 1913. there was begun and holden a July Term of Commissioners Court in and for Titus County Texas. Among those present Presiding. A. O. Browning W. Thompson J. S. Cameron and A. P. Snyook. Esq. J. H. Cooper Sheriff W. L. Kelly Clerk. where the following proceedings were had To Wit:

In the matter of Petition of A. S. Lilly and 63 others for Stock Law Election in Cookville Precinct No 4 July 14-1913.

On this day came on to be considered the Petition of A. S. Lilly and 63 other citizens of Cookville Precinct for a Stock law election in Cookville Precinct no 4 of Titus County Texas To determine whether or not horses mules jacks, jennets, and colts shall be permitted to run at large in the said Justice precinct no 4 of Titus County Texas

The said Justice Precinct no 4 of Titus County Texas is described and bounded as follows. To Wit: Bounded on South as follows.

Beginning at a point on the Morris County line due east of the S & E corner of the Geo. Blofshorn survey. Thence west to S & E corner Thence west with said south boundary line of the Geo. Blofshorn survey to the SW corner of said survey Thence west to the Mt. Pleasant and Rangerfield road a stroke Thence with said road to the E. B. line of Justice Precinct no 1 Titus County Texas a post oak on the Joshua S. Hill survey marked PL (4) and a S. of. brs N 56° W 3/4 to marked PL

Said Precinct no 4 bounded on the W. as follows. Beginning at a PO in the Joshua S. Hill survey marked PL (4) and a block of oak brs N 56° W 4/4 marked PL said PO situated 4 miles due E. from the center of the Court House in Mt. Pleasant Thence N. to the block of oak and Snow Hill Road

road a P.C. tree to S & E. of line marked P.L. Still N. to the
 S. E. & W. P.R. crossing said road about midway between
 what is known as the Alabaminty coal mine and the
 west fence of the Jack Mason farm a P.O. line N and E.
 of line marked P.C. still north entering a small farm
 now owned by Mrs Jack Mason a P.O. line S and W of line
 marked P.C. still N. through said farm a portion of W.P. Wilson
 farm to the Mt. Pleasant and Cookville road a post on line
 south of road marked P.C. and P.M. and then north a S. corner
 of old place now owned by Halley Miller passing through
 his field about 150 yds W. of his house and entering Billy
 Hooper's field, field possibly about 100 yards east of his house
 and entering Thomas Davis' field passing 100 yards west of his
 house and at the edge of timber a block back to E. marked P.L.
 and still N. through timber to Liberty Hill church to the Liberty
 Hill and county line road thence east with the meanderings
 of the Liberty Hill and Morris county line road to the intersection
 of Horse creek thence N. with the meanderings of Horse creek
 to White Oak Creek

Said Precinct is bounded on the north as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Horse creek into White
 Oak Creek thence east down said White Oak Creek in
 an easterly direction with the meanderings of said
 creek to the Morris County line and Titus County Bound
 line

Said Precinct is bounded on the east as follows

Beginning on White Oak Creek at a point
 on the Titus and Morris County boundary line, thence S.
 with said Morris & Titus County boundary line to the place
 of beginning a point on said Morris and Titus County
 boundary line, due east to the S.E. cor of the Geo. Olophron survey

And the court after examining said petition and
 finding it in proper form and signed by the proper
 number of citizens as the law requires is of the opinion
 that said petition should be granted and is hereby granted
 and ordered, and it is further ordered by the court
 that said election is ordered for the 20th day of August
 1913 and J.P. Morisy is hereby appointed moderator of
 Cookville Precinct and Wt. Myers of Lone Star Precinct

In the matter of declaring
 election of special additional
 maintenance Tax ^{on} ^{the} ^{property} ^{of} ^{the} ^{district}
 chapel dist no 30 July 14th 1913

On this day come out to
 by declared the election returns of Newell's Chapel
 School dist no 30. additional maintenance Tax of
 25 cents on the \$100 valuation of Taxable property in
 said School dist no 30. said election held June
 14th 1913. and after making a canvass of said
 return of said election. It was found that "For the
 Tax levied" and it is hereby ordered by
 the court that an additional maintenance Tax
 of 25 cts on the \$ valuation of Taxable property, be
 and is hereby levied on all real and personal
 property each year in said Newell's Chapel
 School district no 30 and shall be paid into
 the school fund of said School district no 30.
 It is further ordered that said maintenance Tax
 be collected in year 1913. and be paid into school
 fund of said School district.

In the matter of resignation
 of Young Lyles as constable } July 14-1913
 Precinct no 9

On this day come
 out to by considered the Resignation of
 Young Lyles constable. Justice precinct no
 and after being considered by the court
 it is of the opinion that said resignation is in
 due form and said resignation is accepted
 by the court and George B. Block is hereby
 appointed constable of said Justice Precinct
 by giving bond of the law requires and
 taking the oath of office and filling all the
 requirements of the law.

In the matter of Surveying & July 14, 1913
Road Precincts Tulus County

On this day come on to be considered the matter of surveying the county, where necessary, into Road Precincts checking each survey cited by any Road Precinct line to its respective district and making blue print of all roads in said Precincts etc.

And after being duly considered it is ordered & decreed by the court that said precinct lines be surveyed, where necessary and that J. H. Borgile be hereby appointed to do said surveying at the rate of \$5.00 per day while in actual service in said surveying etc. and that he choose men to help him in said work of a reasonable compensation, said help to be paid by county.

In the matter of Monthly Report of Town Peace Collector July 14 1913

On this day come on to be examined and approved the report of Town Peace Collector and after considering and checking said Report and found to be correct. It is ordered by the court that said Report be and the same is hereby approved.
