

In the matter of Declaring Aug 29th. 1913
Results of Stock Law Election
Precinct No 4, Titus Co., Tex.

In the matter of conve-
ning returns of an election held in Justice Precinct
No 4, of Titus County, Tex. on the 17th day of Aug 1913
to determine whether or not horses, hogs, fowl, cattle and
cattle should be permitted to run at large in said
Justice Precinct No 4, Titus County Tex. by Sam-
uel Porter County Judge of said County in the pres-
ence of W. T. Cobb Justice of the Peace of Precinct No 4,
Titus County Tex., and W. L. Kelly County Clerk Titus Co.
Tex It appearing from said returns 119 votes
were cast in said election 84 of said votes were
cast for the stock law and 35 votes of which were
cast against said stock law.

It appearing from said returns that there were
49 more votes cast for the stock law than against
the stock law in said Precinct at said election.

By virtue of authority vested in me by law
I declare that the said election was in favor of
of the stock law in said Precinct as follows:
Beginning at and bounded on the South as
follows: Beginning at a point on the Morris Co.
line due E. of S.E. cor. of the big shop mtn Survey
Thence W. to said S.E. cor. Thence W. with said
S.E. line of the big shop mtn sur. to the SW cor. of
said survey. Thence W. by the Mt. Pleasant & Longfield
road, a stake. Thence W. with the said road to the
E.B. line of Justice Precinct One, Titus County Tex. a
post on Joshua Hill sur. mhd P.L. (4) and a B.J. sur.
line N. 56° W. 5¹/₂ m. as mhd P.L. said Precinct No 4. Bounded
on the W as follows: Beginning at a post on Joshua's
Hill sur. mhd P.L. (4) and at B.J. sur N. 56° W. 5¹/₂ m.
mhd P.L. said Post situated 1/2 miles due E. from
the center of court house in Mt. Pleasant Tex. Thence
N. to the blackville and Snow Hill road a 00
hrs south, & east line mhd P.L. Hill N. to the S.E. off
by go crossing said road about midway between what
is known as the Pleasant and mine and the west
face of rock mountain form a R.O. line N. & E. line.

marked S.E. 1/4 then north entering a small farm now owned by Mrs. Jack Moon a Rd. between S. & W. of line marked S.E. 1/4 still N. then south passing a portion of W.W. Willcox's farm to the J.M. Phonous & Cookville Road, a post on line S. of road marked S.C.L. Rd. and C.V. still north at Conner's old place now owned by Walter Melby passing through the field about 130 yards W. of his house and entering Belis Forks field passing about 100 yards E. of his house and entering the Thos. Morris field passing about 150 yds W. of his house and at the edge of timber a fence took for east, S.E. and still N. through timber to Liberty Hill church in the Liberty Hill and County line Road thence E. with the meanderings of the Liberty Hill Morris County line road, to the intersection of Horse Creek Branch N. with the meanderings of Horse Creek to White Oak creek.

Said Precinct No. 4 bounded on the N. as follows, beginning at the intersection of Horse Creek and White Oak Creek, thence E. down said White Oak Creek in an easterly direction with the meanderings of said creek to the Morris County & Titus County boundary line said Precinct No. 4 bounded on the E. as follows:

Beginning on White Oak Creek to a point on the Titus and Morris County boundary line thence S. with said Morris & Titus County boundary line to the place of Beginning a point on said Morris & Titus County Boundary line due E. of the S.E. cor. of the Ses Chapman survey.

And it shall be unlawful for any person to said Stock to run off longer than said Precinct described as aforesaid after Sept. 29th 1913 the 29th day of Aug., being the date on which I issue my proclamation declaring the result of said election and caused my same to be posted on the court house door of the Court House in Titus County, Texas in the town of M. Pleasant, Tex.
