In the matter of Marshal Jones of report from county Sept 8. 1913

On this day come into open court Marshal Jones and made plea to said court of his inability to earn a living on account of loss of eye sight, and after being considered by the court and finding the same worthy. It is ordered that said Marshal Jones be paid the sum of \$5.00 per month from any and all moneys received by said court.
