Moore and 25 other Tax Payers Citizens of Common school district No. 19 of Mills County Texas was presented to me praying that I order an election to be held in said district to determine whether the property Tax paying voters of said district will authorize the levy of a special Tax of 25 cents on each \$100.00 taxable valuation of property in said district to supplement the state school Tax. It appearing to me that said petition is signed by no Protest Tax paying voters residing in said district I therefore order that an election be held at the school house in said district on the 4th day of April 1914 for the purpose of determining whether or not ~~the~~ ^{the} property Tax paying voters of said district will authorize the levy of a special school Tax of 25 cent on each \$100. valuation of taxable property in said district for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund - E. F. Holland, J. A. Perkins, and A. G. Cook are appointed to hold said election E. F. Holland is named as moderator - The sheriff of this county is ordered to give notice of said election by posting 3 notices in said district for 3 weeks prior to the date therein fixed for said election -
