On this day a petition signed by J. M. Moore and 25 other Tax Paying Citizens of Common School district No. 19 & Mt. G. County Texas was presented to me by you, that I order an election to be held in said district to determine whether the property tax paying voters of said district will authorize the levy of a special tax of 25 cents on each \$100⁰⁰ taxable valuation of property in said district to supplement the State school tax. It appearing to me that said petition is signed by no property tax paying voters residing in said district & therefore order that an election be held at the school house in said district on the 4th day of April 1914 for the purpose of determining whether or not the property tax paying voters of said district will authorize the levy of a special school tax of 25 cents on each \$100. valuation of taxable property in said district for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund - E. F. Holland, J. A. Perkins, and A. G. Cook are appointed to hold said election. E. F. Holland is named as manager. The Sheriff of this County is to be in ordered to give notice of said election by posting 3 notices in said district for 3 weeks prior to the date herein fixed for said election -

In the matter of change in boundary line between Forest Grove School District no 32 and Stonewall no 193 { March 9-1913

On this day come on to be considered the petition of C. L. Brown & H. A. Johnson and S. A. Neumann of trustees of Forest Grove School district no 32, for change in boundary line between Forest Grove no 32, and Stonewall dist no 193 as follows:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of C. L. Brown's tract of land thence west with Polis Road 380 ft. thence south 155 ft. thence west 527 ft. thence south 390 ft. thence east 675 ft. thence north 150 ft. thence east 167 ft. thence north 151 ft. to place of beginning, and after being considered by the court it is of the opinion that said petition is well taken and that said change should be made. It is therefore ordered changed as above set out, by the court.
