

All persons will take notice that an election will be held at the State Bank Building in the town of Talco Tular County Texas, on Saturday, May 30 1914, for the purposes of determining whether the qualified voters who are tax payers in said district will authorize the issuance of the coupon bonds of said district to the amount of seven thousand dollars, payable forty years after date, with the option of redemption at any time after one year from date, drawing five per cent interest from date until paid payable annually for the purposes of constructing and equipping a public free school building of brick material within said district and purchasing a site therefor also whether there shall be levied, assessed, and collected

a tax of not to exceed twenty five cents upon each one hundred dollars taxable Valuation of property within said district sufficient to pay interest on and provide a sinking fund with which to pay said bonds at maturity.
