Be it Remembered that on July 13<sup>th</sup> 1914 there was begun and holden a regular term of the Hon. Commissioners Court of Tulsa County, Texas, to-wit: except Hon. Sam Roper County Judge, A. P. Smart, J. W. Thompson & J. C. Conner, all Citizens & Agents Commissioners when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

On this day come on to be considered Treasurer's Annual Report of School Funds, First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant and after comparing the items with Original Report of Treasurer found by said Court that some were in error and it is therefore ordered by the Court that said Report is in all things correct and approved.

The Commissioners Court for Itus County, convened in regular session on July 13<sup>th</sup> 1914, at the Court House in said County, with County Judge Sam Porter, and County Commissioners Mark Brown, Cameron and Thompson present. The County Judge presiding.

When came on to be considered, the matter of establishing the boundaries of Maple Springs Common School District number two in said County. It appearing to the Court that a new school district has been created out of the territory formerly within the boundaries of Maple Springs Common school district number two.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Itus County Texas that the boundaries of Maple Springs Common school district number two of Itus County Texas be fixed and designated as follows, to wit: Situated in Itus County Texas between Sulphur River and White Oak Creek. Beginning at the North East corner of the S.B. Bass survey of Sulphur River. Thence South to the North boundary line of the John Prather. Thence East to the North East corner of the John Prather survey. Thence South with the East boundary lines of the John Prather, Sam Porter, and Joseph Maly surveys to the South East corner of said Joseph Maly survey. Thence West to the North East corner of Daniel C. Boothe survey. Thence South to the North boundary line of the M.E. and C. Ry. Co. survey. Thence East to the North East corner of said M.E. & C. Ry. Co. sur. Thence South to the North boundary line of the Charles V. White sur. Thence East to the North East corner of said White sur. Thence South to the South East corner of said White sur. Thence West to the East boundary line of the O.M. Morris sur. Thence South to the North boundary line of B.B. and C. Ry. Co. sur. Thence East to the North East corner of said B.B. and C. Ry. Co. sur. Thence South to White Oak Creek. Thence West with the meanderings of said creek to the South East corner of the Edward Hotts survey. Thence North to the North East corner of the Edward Hotts survey. Thence West to the North South East corner of the Martina Hess Dugado sur. Thence North to the South North East corner of said Dugado sur on the South boundary line of the John R. Slaughter sur. Thence East to the South East corner of said Slaughter survey. Thence North to the South West corner of said John R. Slaughter survey. Thence East to South East corner of Alfred Watson survey. Thence North to South East corner of A.J. Dry survey. Thence West to South West corner of A.J. Dry sur. Thence West to East boundary line of James M. McCallough survey.

Thence North to the North East Corner of James W. McCallough survey - Thence West to South East Corner of J. R. McElhon survey - Thence North to North East Corner of J. R. McElhon survey - Thence East to South East Corner of P. J. Mann survey - Thence North to North East Corner of Solomon M. Durner survey on Sulphur River. Thence East with the meanderings of Sulphur River to the place of Beginning containing the following surveys and acres shown in each.
