December 15<sup>th</sup> 1914 -

On this day a Petition signed by G W Rust and J D Otter Tax Paying Citizens of Common School Dist No 25 of Tittus County Texas was presented to me Praying that I order an Election to be held in said District to determine whether the Property Tax paying Voters of said District will authorize the Levy of a Special Tax of 10 cents on the \$100<sup>00</sup> Tax able Valuation of Property in said District to supplement the State School Tax It appearing to me that said Petition is signed by 20 Property Tax Paying Voters Residing in said District I therefore order that an Election be held at the School House in said District on the 9th day of January 1915 for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the Property Tax paying Voters of said District will authorize the Levy of a Special School Tax of 10 cents on each \$100<sup>00</sup> Valuation of Taxable Property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund R W Yeagers Secy Messing and G W Rust are appointed to hold said Election G W Rust is named as Manager the Sheriff of Tittus County Texas is ordered to give notice of said Election by posting 3 notices in said District for 3 weeks Inasmuch as the date herein fixed for said Election
