Utter Tax Paying Citizens of Common School Dist No 25 Of Titus County, Texas was Presented to me Praying that I order An Election to be held in Said District to determine whether the Property Tax Paying Voters of Said District will Authorize the levying of a Special Tax of 10 cents on their \$100<sup>00</sup> Taxable Valuation of Property in Said District to supplement the Standard Tax & appearing to me that Said Petition is signed by 20 Property Tax Paying Voters Residing in Said District I Therefor order that an Election be held at the School House in Said District on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January 1915 for the Purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the Property Tax Paying Voters of Said District will Authorize the levying of a Special School Tax of 10 cents on each \$100<sup>00</sup> Valuation of Taxable Property in Said District for the Purpose of supplementing the State School Fund for Years to come And G.W. Rust & L.G. Utter are appointed to hold said Election. G.W. Rust is named as manager the Sheriff of Titus County Texas is ordered to give notice of said election by Posting 3 notices in said district for 3 weeks before to ~~and~~ the date herein fixed for said election.
