

Notice of Election

All persons will take notice that an election will be held in common School district Number Two of Titus county Texas at the School house thereof on the eight day of May 1915 for the purpose of submitting to the tax paying voters of the said district the question of the issuance of the Coupon Bonds of the said district to the amount of One Thousand dollars to become due and payable 20 years after date with the option of redemption at any time after one year from date. to bear interest at the rate of 5 percent per annum from date until paid payable annually for the purpose of constructing and equipping a public free School building within said district and purchasing a site there for and the levy assessment or collection of an annual tax against all taxable property in said district of a rate sufficient to pay the interest on the said bonds and to create a sinking fund with which to pay the principal ^{and} maturity.
