Election Return Council } Oct 11-1915  
School District No 7.

On this day came  
out to be considered the Election Returns  
held Sept 11<sup>th</sup> 1915. To decide whether or not  
a special maintenance tax of 25 cents on  
the 100 dollar valuation of taxable property  
in said district should be assessed  
and after considering said returns  
the court found that there were cast  
"For special tax" 16 votes, and against  
special tax" 5 votes"

It is therefore ordered and decreed by  
the court that "for the tax" averted doth  
that there shall be levied and collected each  
year 25c on the one hundred dollar valua-  
tion of taxable property in said council  
School District No 7, for the maintenance  
of said school.

In the matter of a Representative }  
to the Convention of Good Roads } Oct 11, 1915  
on a highway from Port to Preston

On this day came  
out to be considered the proposition of sending  
Representative to Abaline to Road convention  
on National Highway and after considering  
same It is ordered that Ed. Judge Sam Porter  
be sent to Represent Texas and that his  
expenses be paid out of County fund by  
issued script.

In the matter of agricultural } Oct 11-1915  
Demonstration at Ft Texas Co }  
County Agricultural

On this day came  
out to be considered the matter of discontinuing  
agricultural demonstration, W.C. Negro and  
demonstration receiving \$40.00 per month for 10  
months for each year.

After due consideration the court is of the

specimen that said person had in work  
or and the same is hereby discontinued  
and that the salary of \$40<sup>00</sup> per month to be paid  
said H.C. Myers Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> 1915

In the matter of Report } Oct. 11-1915  
of Mrs Tom Price Tax collector }

On this day came  
up to be considered the monthly Report  
of Mrs Tom Price Tax collector. After  
examining and comparing same with receipts  
the same is approved.

State of Texas County of Titus The Commissioners of  
Titus County in session Nov. 11<sup>th</sup> 1915. made and entered  
of record the following order. Under and by authority of chap-  
ter 32 of the General Law of the State, 32<sup>nd</sup> Legislature 1911  
That the sum of four hundred dollars be and is hereby appro-  
priated and set aside as a quarterly out of the funds of Titus  
County to supplement the funds of the U.S. Department  
of Agriculture in paying the salary of the county  
agent of the Farmers Co-operative Association  
work. Said sum shall be paid out upon receipt  
of vouchers drawn and approved by the department  
authorities by check and become available again  
after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Jan 1916 and as long as the U.S.  
Department of Agriculture will conduct said work in said  
this court order shall continue that the sum of  
\$400<sup>00</sup> be paid out as above stated annually until  
woked of the close of a season by special order of the  
Commissioner's Court of Titus County. In case some  
finds it necessary to revoke the above order. The order con-  
tinuing same shall be passed only during the month  
of October or November which time will be near the close  
of a season and the year work. Otherwise this order  
shall remain in full force from year to year
