On this day came out to be canvassed election returns for County Trustees. Two to be elected and after canvassing all 1000 returns it was found that the members of the board were W. U. Fleming and J. H. Stephens received the highest number of votes in the aggregate. It is therefore ordered and decreed that W. U. Fleming and J. H. Stephens are declared elected.

Court continuing in session April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1916. when came on to be considered the application of the Trustees of common school district No 20 of Titus County, Texas, to sell the school house and site now owned by said district. Whereupon a motion was made and seconded that the application be granted - be motion carried.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the application of the trustees of common school district No. 20 of Titus County, Texas, be and the same is hereby granted and that said trustees sell the school house and site now owned by said district and apply the proceeds of such sale as the law requires.

On this <sup>the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1916</sup> day, Come on to be considered the petition of L. C. Stroman and 17 other Property Tax Paying Voters some being a majority of the Property Tax Paying Voters in said District. Residing in Common School District No 34 in Titus County Texas praying that an election be held ordered to be held in said District for the purpose of submitting to the Resident Property Tax Paying Voters of the said District the question of increasing the special tax of said District to a rate not to exceed 20 cents on the each \$1,000<sup>00</sup> taxable valuation of all taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said District. I find that the petition is signed by a majority of the Property Tax Paying Voters of the said District and that the petition is in proper form and should be granted.

It is therefore ordered that an election be held at the school house in said District on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1916 for the purpose of submitting to the Property Tax Paying Voters of the said District the question of the increase of the special tax of the said District to an annual rate not to exceed 20 cents on the each \$1,000<sup>00</sup> valuation of taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said District.

It is further ordered that J. W. Rountree, L. C. Stroman & Lastron are appointed to hold said election and make returns there of as required by law.
