Be it Remembered that on Monday the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1916 there was by law and Holden a Regular Term of the Hon. Commissioners Court. Hon. Sam Porter Presiding Commissioners Kip Thoms, Sims & Smith, Present W. Kelly Clerk, Jas. A. Cooper Sheriff when the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of Petition of June 12-1916  
W. H. Tobb et al for Highway

On this day came on to be considered the petition of W. H. Tobb et al for Public Highway leading from the Pittsburg road of Sanders place between Nemmon and Snider and between W. H. Tobb and Nemmon and W. H. Tobb and S. C. Tobb place then to my W. H. Tobb place and then between Snider's place and the Rutland road of land and the McLean and Oliver place.

Said Petition for Highway granted and ordered a public Highway this 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1916.

In the matter of Election of June 12-1916  
Returns C. S. A. No 13

On this day came on to be considered the Returns of a public election held in Cambridge School district No 13 held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1916 for the purpose of deciding whether or not a tax of 50c on the \$100. valuation should be levied, and after comparing said returns it appeared that there were cost for the total 15 votes & against the tax 300. It is therefore ordered that for the tax carried and that said 50c be levied assessed and collected.
