

## Notice C. S. D. No 13.

Notice is given to all property tax paying voters residing in Cannon School District No 13 of Teton County, T. C. O. that an election will be held at the school house in said district on the 25th day of Nov, 1916 for the purpose of submitting to the property tax paying voters of said district the question of the issuance of the Coupon Bonds of said district to the amount of Fifteen Hundred Dollars to draw five per cent interest per annum from date until paid payable annually to become due and payable twenty years after date with the option to redeem them at any time after one year from date for the purpose of constructing and equipping a Public Free School Building within said district and the levy assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property within said district of a rate sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it accrues and to create a sinking fund with which to pay the principal thereof at maturity. Said Election was ordered to be held by the County Judge of Teton County T. C. O. on the 27th day of October 1916 and this notice is given in obedience to said order and the laws of the State of T. C. O. I, W. H. Boyle, of my office in the city of Mt. Pleasant T. C. O. this the 24th day of Oct. A. D. 1916

It is hereby ordered and decreed by the court that said boundary line as it now exists of this court heretofore made be and the same is hereby approved with the following changes: that said line begin at the beginning corner as mentioned in the order of this court of date Nov. 17<sup>th</sup> and recorded in the minutes of this court Vol 4 page 348. and run thence with said line as in and also established to a point due south of the said corner of the said fence as it now exists crossing the roadline on the old Bob Ayler place recently sold by Mr. J. Davis and wife to J. J. Hodges and from said point running thence north to the said old corner of said good and on north with said good fence to the NW of the said good fence to the NE corner of the said good fence due south to where said line again intersects the original line between precincts nos 4 and 5. and thence with said original line to the place ~~beginning~~ where it terminates in the Tllus and Morris as line said line being thus established so as to place the said Davis Residence in Justice precinct no 5. of Tllus County Tex

In the matter of Maintenance Nov. 13, 1916

On November 13<sup>th</sup> 1916 came on to be heard the matter of changing the public road in Justice Precinct No 8 of Teras County, Texas.

It appearing to the Commissioners Court of Teras County, Texas, that the public road in Justice Precinct No 8 of Teras County, Texas, leading south from the town of Winfield, Texas, to Chondula Creek and on south wite and through the community, where Tom pointed and lines should be changed so that the same will hereafter commences at the point where the Sulphur Springs and Mt. Pleasant Turno, running West from Mt. Pleasant, Texas, North West towards the town of Winfield, Texas and thence south along, and through the land adjoining said Sulphur Springs road, belonging to Mrs. M. S. Bannister and continuing south according to the survey made by T. S. Miller Engineer. To and including the entire length of said survey as now laid out for the construction of the good road, by said Justice Precinct No 8 of Teras County, Texas.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Teras County, Texas, that the public road above described be changed as above described, and stated,

that D. B. Crocker, J. M. McLean, J. W. Thompson, Ed. Yegaris, and J. M. Best be and are now appointed a jury of view to view, inspect, investigate and determine what damage, if any, will be done to M. S. Bannister and his land by reason of such change in said road, and to make a report of their findings to this Court as the law requires.
