

## Notice C 80. No 13.

Notice is given to all property taxpaying voters residing in Common School District No 13 of Titus County, Texas, that an election will be held at the school house in said district on the 25th day of Nov. 1916 for the purpose of submitting to the property taxpaying voters of said district the question of the issuance of the coupon bonds of said district to the amount of Fifteen Hundred Dollars to bear five per cent interest per annum from date until paid payable annually to become due and payable twenty years after date with the option to redeem them at any time after one year from date for the purpose of constructing and equipping a Public Free School Building within said district and the tax assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property within said district of a rate sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it accrues and to create a sinking fund with which to pay the principal thereof at maturity. Your Election voters ordered to be held by the County Judge of Titus County, Texas, on the 27th day of October 1916 and this notice is given in obedience to said order and the laws of the State of Texas, of my office in the city of Mt Pleasant Texas this the 24th day of Oct. On this the 1st day of Nov. A.D. 1916 come on to be considered the change in the boundary line between Justice Precincts nos 4 & 5. It is hereby ordered and decreed by the court that said boundary line as it now stands be changed with the following changes; that said line begin at the beginning corner as mentioned in the order of this court of date Nov. 17<sup>th</sup>, and recorded in the minutes of this court Vol 4 page 348. and run thence with said line as in said order established to a point due south of the SW corner of the good fence as it now stands passing through the residence on the old Bob Clegg place recently sold by Mr. Davis and wife to J. H. Goodsey and from said point running thereof north to the said SW corner of said good and on north with said good fence to the NW of the said good fence lost with the north string of said good fence to the NE corner of the said good fence due south where said line again intersects the original line between Precincts nos 4 and 5. and thence with said original line to the place where it terminates in the Taz and Morris Co line said line being thus established so as to place the said Davis Residence in Justice Precinct no 5. of Tazewell County Taz.

On this day came on to be considered the Returns of Election in Common School Dist No 12 held on 24<sup>th</sup> day of Oct 1916, and after consideration whereupon it was found by the Court that "Taxes now demanded to be paid exceed 300 on the \$100" valuation of taxable property in said C.S.D. 6 votes being opposed said to be 0 votes and after due consideration the Court declared "without cause" and said tax is ordered levied assessed and collected.

In the Matter of Maintenance Nov. 15, 1916  
W. Panther

On the day of same  
to be considered the matter of main-  
tenance for W. Panther. And to be  
being considered by the court, the  
Court ordered that monthly main-  
tenance be Reduced from \$25<sup>00</sup> per month  
to \$15<sup>00</sup> per month.

On November 13<sup>th</sup> 1916 came on to be heard the matter of changing the public road in Justice Precinct No 8 of Hays County, Texas.

It appearing to the Commissioners Court of Hays County, Texas, that the public road in Justice Precinct No 8 of Hays County, Texas, leading south from the town of Milfield, Texas, to Blundell Creek and on such route and through the community where John Bonner and others should be charged so that the same will thereafter commence at the point where the Sulphur Springs and Mt Pleasant Turn, leading west from Mt Pleasant, Texas, North Tex towards the town of Milfield, Texas and thence south along and through the land adjoining said Sulphur Springs road belonging to Mrs M. S. Bonner and continuing south according to the survey made by T. D. Gilder Engineer the said including the latter length of said survey as now laid out for the construction of the good road by said Justice Precinct No 8 of Hays County, Texas.

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Hays County, Texas, that the public road above described be charged as above described and stated, that J. P. Croft, J. W. McLean, J. T. Thompson, E. J. Hayes and J. M. Beck be and are now appointed a jury of view to view said road, investigate and determine what damage, if any, will be done to M. S. Bonner and his land by reason of such change in said road, and to make report of their findings to this court as to the same.

Which order was passed by the unanimous vote of all the Commissioners Court of Hays County, Texas.
