The State of Texas In the matter of employing
County Officers an agent of the Farmers Cooperative
Demonstration Work in Titus County, Texas

It is ordered by the Court that the sum \$50.00 additional be and the same is hereby appropriated and set aside annually out of the funds of Titus County to supplement the funds of the U. S. Department of Agriculture and the A. M. College of Texas, in paying the salary of the County Lady Home Demonstration Agent of the Farmers Cooperative Demonstration work and Extension Service in Titus County.

Said sum shall be paid out upon receipt of vouchers drawn and approved by the authorized Agent of said extension Service and become available on Feb 1st 1917, or as soon thereafter as is practical for the U. S. Department of Agriculture and the A. M. College of Texas to open the work. This order shall be continuous unless mutually revoked of the U. S. Department of Agriculture and the Extension Service of the A. M. College of Texas and the Com. Court of Titus County.
