Be it remembered that on this the 12th day of March A.D. 1917 there was begun and holden a regular term of the Hon. Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas with the following officers present to wit: Hon. J.W. Pable Judge, A. P. Smart, J.W. Edwards, B.G. Holmes and W.M. King Commissioners, and C.S. Neugent Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

March 12th 1917

On this day came on to be considered by the Court the matter of allowing Smith Bros. the sum of \$2000⁰⁰ same being a part of the percentage held back out of the good road funds of Road District No. 3 of Titus County until the roads were completed.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that Smith Bros. be allowed the sum of \$2000⁰⁰ out of the good road funds of Road Dist. No. 3 of Titus County.

March 12th 1917

On this day came on to be considered by the Court the matter of approving the Depository Bond of the School funds etc. of Titus County of the State National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, and after said bond being examined by the Court, the Court is of the opinion that said bond is in proper form as required by law and is signed by good and sufficient sureties. It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that said Depository Bond be in all things approved.

March 12th 1917

On this day came on to be considered by the court the matter of killing and vacating the old road right of way in Road District No. 3 of Titus County, Texas. Said road beginning where the old road leading from Tates to Harts Bluff leaves the mud road in front of Mrs. Blackburn's residence leading N.E. to the R.D. Wm. Lux near Hight Fishback's residence.

It is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that said above road be and the same is hereby killed & vacated.

On this day came on to be considered by the court the application of J. H. Hammond, County Treasurer of Titus Co. to transfer the sum of \$310.⁰⁰ from the Court house and jail fund of Titus County to the General County fund.

It is ordered and adjudged by the court that said sum of \$310.⁰⁰ be transferred from the said Court house and jail fund to the General County fund of Titus Co.
