Be it remembered that on this the 25th day of August A.D. 1917 there was begun and holden a Special term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the following officers present to wit; Commissioners, A.P. Smart, J.W. Edwards, M. King and B.G. Holmes. C. Menquist County Clerk, J.W. Fable Judge and W.C. Smith Sheriff, where the following proceedings were had to wit,

In the matter of the returns of $\frac{3}{3}$ Aug 25, 1917
Amendment Election $\frac{3}{3}$

On this day the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas considered the returns of the election held August 21st 1917, to amend ^{Article 16th} the Constitution of the State of Texas. After considering said returns the Court finds that 234 voted for the said amendment and that 236 voted against said amendment.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that against said amendment carried.

In the matter of receiving $\frac{3}{3}$ Aug 25, 1917
bids to publish delinquent tax list $\frac{3}{3}$

On this day it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that J.W. Fable County Judge, be authorized to receive bids from various news papers of Titus County, and let the contract to have the delinquent tax list of Titus County published as required by law.

In the matter of allowing $\frac{3}{3}$ August 25, 1917

On this day it is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that Mrs. Petto be allowed the sum of \$8.00 as charity donation. Said amount to be paid out of the General County Fund of Titus County.

In the matter of allowing ³ Aug. 25, 1917
H.B. Dickson \$650⁰⁰ ₂

On this day it is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that H.B. Dickson Tax Assessor, be allowed the sum of \$650⁰⁰ for assessing the taxes of Titus County for this year, same being his commission as provided by law except \$200⁰⁰ that has heretofore been paid
