

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas met in a special session thereof at the Court House of said County in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas on the 24th day of September A.D. 1917 with the following members present to wit:-

J W Tubb County Judge, and County Commissioners Smart, Holmes, King and Edwards, and County Clerk C T Neugebauer.

There came to be considered by the Court the matter of the petition of Mr T D Hall and eighty-six other resident property tax-paying voters of Road District Number Four of Titus County, Texas, praying that this Court order an election to be held within said district in the time and manner required by law for the purpose of submitting to the resident property tax-paying voters thereof the question of the issuance of the coupon Bonds of said district and the levy, assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property within said district of a rate sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds.

County Commissioner Edwards offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by the court which motion was seconded by County Commissioner Smart. The order is as follows, to wit:-

"It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that a petition signed by Mr T D Hall and eighty-six other resident property tax-paying voters of road District Number Four of Titus County Texas praying that the Commissioners Court order an election to be held within said district in the time and manner required by law for the purpose of submitting to the property tax-paying voters residing within said district the question of the issuance of the coupon Bonds of said district and the levy, assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property

property of the said district, of a rate sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds.

It further appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, that the said petition is in proper and legal form, is signed by at least fifty resident property tax paying voters of Road District Number Four of Titus County Texas and, should be granted.

It is, therefore ordered adjudged and decreed, by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas in accordance with the said petition, that an election be held in road district Number Four of Titus County Texas in the rear offices of the Bank Building in the town of Cooksville, Texas on the thirtieth day of October A.D. nineteen hundred seventeen at which there shall be submitted to the resident property tax paying voters of road District Number Four of Titus County Texas, the question of the issuance of the coupon Bonds of said district to the amount of twenty thousand Dollars to bear interest from date at the rate of six per cent per annum until paid, payable semi-annually, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized Graveled and paved roads and turnpikes and in aid thereof within said district, to become due and payable as follows, to wit:-

\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1919
\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1920
\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1921
\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1922
\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1923

\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1926
\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1927

\$1000.00 to become due and payable April 10th 1931

\$1000⁰⁰ to become due and payable April 10th 1932
 \$1000⁰⁰ to become due and payable April 10th 1933
 \$1000⁰⁰ to become due and payable April 10th 1934
 \$1000⁰⁰ to become due and payable April 10th 1935
 \$1000⁰⁰ to become due and payable April 10th 1936
 \$1000⁰⁰ to become due and payable April 10th 1937
 \$1000⁰⁰ to become due and payable April 10th 1938

Provided that said interest which shall accrue to April 10th 1919 shall be payable there and the levy, assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property within said district of a rate sufficient to pay the principal and interest on said bonds as it shall accrue.

Mrs. Dock Keith, as presiding judge, W H Burford, as assistant judge, and A T Blalock and B B Stevens, as clerks are appointed to hold the said election and make returns thereof as the law requires.

The ballot which shall be used in said election shall be as follows, to-wit:-

Official Ballot.

"For the issuance of the coupon bonds of Road District Number Four of Titus County Texas, to the amount of Twenty thousand Dollars, to bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum from date until paid, payable semi annually, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, Graveled and paved roads and turnpikes and ice aid thereto in said district and the levy, assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property within said district of a rate sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds as it accrues.

Against the issuance of the coupon Bonds of road District Number Four of Titus County Texas to the amount of Twenty thousand Dollars, to bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum until paid, payable semi-annually for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and

operating macadamized Gravelled and paved roads and turn pikes and in aid thereof in said district and the levy, assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property within said district of a rate sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds and accrued.

All those persons desiring to vote for the Bonds and the tax will cancel the latter expression on the ballot and all those persons desiring to vote against the bonds and the tax will cancel the former expression of the ballot -

Said Road District Number Four of Titus County Texas by name and bounds is described as follows, to wit:-

Situated in Titus County Texas and beginning at the Southwest corner of the Mr. Burke survey which is on the East Boundary line of Justice Precinct Number Four of Titus County Texas about four miles north from a point four miles east of the Court House of said County in the city of Mt. Pleasant Texas; - thence north, with the West Boundary line of said Burke survey, and the East Boundary line of said Precinct, 1344 Varas to the South Boundary line of the Edward Evans survey, continuing North across the said Evans survey, 1344 Varas to its North Boundary line, which is in the South Boundary line of the Seth Oryor Survey and on north across said Oryor Survey 1370 Varas to the North Boundary line of said Oryor Survey - thence east with the North Boundary line of said Oryor Survey to its North East corner continuing east across Daniel Hightower Survey to its East Boundary line, which is the West Boundary line of another Seth Oryor Survey thence North with the last named line to the North West corner of said Oryor Survey - thence east with the North Boundary line of said Oryor Survey to the North East corner of said survey; thence south with said Oryor East Boundary line, which is J. T. Good-

man's west Boundary line, to the south east corner of said Oregon survey thence south 80 varas thence east 343 varas thence North 938 varas thence east 618 varas a state in the Butte's west Boundary line, which is in the Daniel Laramie survey, thence north to the south Boundary line of the C Butte survey thence East with the south line of said Butte Survey to its South East Corner thence North 475 yards thence East 506- $\frac{1}{3}$ yards to Mr Keith's North West Corner; thence East with Mr Keith's north Boundary line 1344 varas, his North East corner, thence North 50 varas thence East 588 varas to Mr McDonald's North West corner thence East with Mr McDonald's North Boundary line 434 varas his northerly North East corner thence South with Mr McDonald's East Boundary line to his East corner thence East with Mr McDonald's North Boundary line to his Easterly North East corner thence East 460 varas to an East corner of J O Lavigne survey thence East across said Lavigne survey to the east Boundary line of Siles County Texas thence south with said County line to the south Boundary line of the Mr McDonald survey thence west 125 varas to Wright's south East corner thence west with his south Boundary line to his south west corner 950 varas thence west with the south Boundary line of the John Seigert survey to the East Boundary line of the Jane Clark survey thence south 350 varas thence west 370 varas thence south 800 varas - thence west 1697 varas to the South East corner of the J B Early survey thence south 22 varas thence west 150 varas to the North west corner of Mr B Tomley's land thence south to Tomley's South west corner thence East to his East corner thence in a southeasterly direction to his southerly South west corner thence East 335 varas thence North 51 varas thence East 90 varas the North East corner the to southland tract of land - thence south with his east Boundary line to his South East corner thence west to his south west corner thence North to point of intersection with South Boundary line of O Keith Survey

The County Judge put the motion for a vote
of the members of the Commissioners Court
of Titus County Texas, with the request that as
many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and all
those who opposed it to vote "no".

County Commissioners Smart, Holmes,
King and Edwards voted "aye" none voted "no".

The County Judge declared the motion carried
and the order passed.

The foregoing minutes of the Commissioners
Court of Titus County, Texas, read and in all

Notice of Election to be held
In Road District Number
Four of Tipton County Texas.

All persons will take notice that an election will be held in Road District Number Four of Tipton County Texas, in the rear office of the Bank Building in the town of Cookville, Texas on the thirtieth day of October Nineteen Hundred Seventeen for the purpose of submitting to the property tax paying voters who reside therein the question of the issuance of the coupon Bonds of said district to the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars to draw interest from date at the rate of five per cent per annum until paid payable semi-annually except the interest which shall accrue to April 10th 1919, which will be payable therefor the purpose of constructing maintaining and operating Macadamized Graveled and paved Roads and Turnpikes and in aid thereof within said district to become due and payable as follows, to wit:-

And the levy assessment and collection of an annual tax against all taxable property within said district at a rate sufficient to pay the principal and interest upon said bonds as it matures.

The said district by metes and bounds is described as follows to wit:-

Situated in Titus County Texas and beginning at the Southwest corner of the Mr. Burke survey which is on the east boundary line of Justice Precinct Number One of Titus County Texas, about four miles North of a point four miles East of the Court House of Titus County Texas, in the City of Mrs. Pleasant Texas. - Hence North with the East Boundary line of said Burke survey and the East Boundary line of said precinct 13 1/4 Varas to the South Boundary line of the Edwards Evans survey containing North across the said Evans survey 13 1/4 Varas to its North.

Tabb, County Judge of Titus County Texas, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by law, and in obedience thereto give notice and order that said election be held at the time, place and upon the subject matter hereinabove set forth, and as ordered by the commissioners Court of Titus County Texas.
