

October Special Term 1917

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a special session at the Court House of said County in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on the 20th day of October A.D. 1917, with the following members present, to wit: J.W. Fabb, County Judge, County Commissioners, Smart, Holmes, King and Edwards, and County Clerk, C. Meunier.

Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, where the following proceedings were had to wit:

Came on to be considered by the Court the matter of creating Road District No. 5 of Titus County, Texas. Mr. J.W. Edwards, County Commissioner, offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by the Court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, A.P. Smart. The order is as follows, to wit:

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that it is desirable and necessary that road district number five of Titus County, Texas, be now created for the purpose of enabling the property tax-paying voters residing therein to determine whether they shall issue bonds within said district and construct, maintain and operate macadamized, graveled and paved roads and turnpikes therein.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that Road District number five of Titus County, Texas be, and the same is now created and that the metes and bounds of the same shall be as follows, to wit: Situated South East from the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, in Titus County and beginning at the point of intersection of the South Boundary line of Road District No. 4 of Titus County, Texas, and the East boundary line of Justice Precinct number one of Titus County, Texas, thence East with the South boundary line of Road District no. 4 of Titus County, Texas, to the east boundary line of Titus County, Texas, which is also the

West boundary line of Morris County, Texas, Thence south with said County line to the south boundary line of the m.k. & T. R.R. right of way, Thence with the south boundary line of the m.k. & T. R.R. right of way to Cypress Creek, Thence up Cypress Creek with its meanderings to the south east corner of Justice Precinct number one of Titus County, Tex. Thence North with the east boundary line of Justice Precinct no. one of Titus County, Texas to the place of beginning.

The County Judge of Titus County, Texas put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and all those who opposed it to vote "no" County Commissioner, Smart, Holmes, King and Blizard voted "aye" None voted "no". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

It is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that the County Treasurer except from the Guaranty State Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, State National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, and the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, all interest accumulated on Road District funds of Road Districts one and 2 of Titus County, Texas at the rate of 2% on daily balances for the length of time such funds have been on deposit in said Banks. Such funds were deposited one third of the whole in each of said Banks.

Passed on Oct. 20th 1917 by unanimous vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas.
