

November Term A.D. 1917

Be it remembered that on this the 12th day of Nov. 1917, there was begun and held a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, with the following officers present to wit, J.W. Tabb, County Judge, A.P. Smart, J.W. Adubado, Wm. King and O.L. Holmes, County Commissioners, and C.G. Murgid Clerk. Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Resignation of Jno. Whitcomb 3 Nov. 12, 1917.
as Constable of Precinct #1 3

On this day came on to be considered by the Court the Resignation of Jno. Whitcomb, as Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County, Texas, and the court after considering said application, voted unanimously to accept said

Application of E.H. Horton 3 Nov. 12, 1917
to be appointed Const. of Pn. #1 3

On this day came on to be considered by the Court the Application of E.H. Horton to be appointed Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County, Texas, to fill out the unexpired term of J. Whitcomb.

The County Judge put the motion that as many of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus Co. Texas, that was in favor of appointing E.H. Horton Constable of Precinct 1, to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no" 3 voted "aye" and 2 voted "no".

It is ordered, and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that E.H. Horton be and he is hereby appointed Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County, Texas.

Pauper allowed money 3 Nov. 12, 1917.

On this day the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, Voted to allow Mrs. Crystal Waller the sum of \$250 in addition to the amount heretofore allowed by the Commissioners Court, making the total sum of \$100 per month to be paid out of the Gen. Co. Fund of Titus Co.
