

November Term A.D. 1917

Be it remembered that on this the 12th day of Nov. 1917, there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, with the following officers present to wit, J.W. Fable, County Judge, A.P. Smart, J.W. Edwards, Wm. King and B.G. Holmes, County Commissioners, and J. Murgess Clerk. Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County Texas, where the following proceedings were had to wit;

Resignation of Jno. Whitcomb $\frac{3}{3}$ Nov. 12, 1917.
as Constable of Precinct #1 $\frac{3}{3}$

On this day came on to be considered by the Court the resignation of Jno. Whitcomb, as Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County Texas, and the court after considering said application, voted unanimously to accept same

Application of Ed. Horton $\frac{3}{3}$ Nov. 12, 1917
to be appointed Const of Pr. #1 $\frac{3}{3}$

On this day came on to be considered by the Court the application of Ed. Horton to be appointed Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County Texas, to fill out the unexpired term of J. Whitcomb

The County Judge put the motion that as many of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus Co. Texas, that was in favor of appointing Ed. Horton Constable of Precinct 1. To vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no" & voted "aye" and 2 voted "no".

It is ordered, and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that Ed. Horton be and he is hereby appointed Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County Texas.

Pauper allowed money $\frac{3}{3}$ Nov. 12, 1917.

On this day the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas voted to allow Mrs. Crystal Waddell the sum of \$250 in addition to the amount heretofore allowed by the Commissioners Court, making the total sum of \$1000 per month to be paid out of the Gen. Co. Fund of Titus Co.
