It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that J. F. Cameron be in all things appointed Commissioner of Precincts nos. 4, 5 & 7 of Titus Co. Tex.

2-1/2 miles N. E. of Mount Pleasant, and being a part of the Joseph
A. Deale survey, to Isaac W. Williams, and it being made to appear
to the court that in locating the new road, there was used and ap-
propriated of the lands belonging to the said Isaac W. Williams
certain lands across his premises for which no charge was made
and that the old road bed across his land being in amount
about equal to the the other lands used and appropriated.
Therefore be it resolved, by the Commissioners Court of Tipton
County, Texas that the Hon J. W. Falls County Judge of Tipton Co.
Texas, he and he is hereby fully authorized in consideration
of the lands used as aforesaid, in the name of and on
behalf of the County of Tipton, in State of Texas, to make to the
said Isaac W. Williams, a quit claim, conveying to the
following described tract of land.

Being a part of said Joseph A. Deale survey in
said Tipton County, located about 2-1/2 miles N. E. of
Mt Pleasant, and beginning at the point in the N. B. line of the
said Isaac Williams tract, formerly owned by Mrs. Gallagher
where the S. B. line of the old public road, now abandoned,
crosses the same. Thence with the S. B. line of the said old road
to Isaac Williams S. B. line. Thence N. to the N. B. line of the old road
thence in a southwesterly direction with said old road to
Williams N. B. line. Thence south to the place of beginning.
