

April Term 1919

Be it remembered that on this 14th day of April 1919 there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas at the Court House of said County in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present to wit; J. W. Falk County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. M. King, T. B. Brown and W. L. Wheeler Commissioners, C. J. Meargent County Clerk and W. W. Smith Sheriff, when the following proceedings were had to wit;

In the matter of the Depository
of the County Funds of Titus
County Texas including the School Funds.

On this the 14th day of April, A. D. 1919 at a regular session of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, came on to be considered the matter of the depository of the County funds of said County, and the matter of bonds of the depository heretofore selected, and it appearing to the Court that the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, which made the highest bid for said funds, including the school funds, was awarded and selected as the depository of said funds on the 10th day of February, 1919, and that it has filed its bond for the school funds as provided and required by law which bond was by this Court approved on the 25th day of February, A. D. 1919, and said bank having on this date presented a bond for the faithful performance of its duties as required and conditioned by law, as the depository of the County funds other than the school funds, and the Court having considered the same finding that the said bond is a good and solvent bond and conditioned, and payable as required and provided by law and for the proper amount.

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that said bond be and the same is hereby in all things approved.

the said First National Bank of Mt Pleasant
Texas be and it is hereby selected and designated
by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas
as the depository of the funds of the County,
including School funds, until sixty days
after the time fixed by law for the next
selection of a depository, to wit; until sixty
days after the regular meeting in February of this
Court, in 1921, being the first February after the
next general election.

The County Treasurer of Titus County, Texas
and the present depository of the School funds
of this County, are hereby directed immediately
to transfer to the said The First National Bank
of Mt Pleasant, Texas all funds now held
by them in their respective capacities.
