

Be it remembered that on this the 22nd day of April 1919 there was begun and holden a Special Term of the Commissioners Court of Teras County, Texas, at the Court House there in the City of Mt. Pleasant Texas, with the following members present to wit: J. D. Fabb, County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. M. King, W. A. Lee and G. A. Brown, Commissioners, W. W. Smith, Sheriff, and O. Mergent, Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

TICK ERADICATION }

On this the 22nd day of April 1919 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Teras Co. Texas the matter of taking up the work of tick eradication for Teras County, where Commissioner Brown made a motion that the court take up the tick eradication work and that each County Commissioner Commissioner of said County employ a suitable man to look after and superintend the matter of Cattle dipping in his respective Commissioner's Precinct of said County, and that A. P. Smart be appointed to purchase material necessary for construction of Vats and for dipping purposes, which motion was seconded by Commissioner King. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the Commissioners Court of Teras County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "ay" and those opposed to vote "no" all Commissioners voted "ay" none voted "no" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed
