

But it is remembered that on this the 2nd day of June 1919 there was begun and haden a special term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the following members present to wit; J. Webb, County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. M. King, W. A. Lee and T. B. Brown, Commissioners, W. W. Smith, Sheriff, and C. Mergent, County Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to wit;

In the Matter of Counting  
Returns of Election Amendments.

On this the 2nd day of June 1919 the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas canvassed the returns of the election held throughout Titus County on May 24<sup>th</sup> 1919, and finds that said Election resulted as follows, to wit;

For Prohibition 590 against Prohibition 586, For the Amendment to Section 7 Art 6 of the Constitution of the State of Texas 433, against said Section 7 Art 6, 803, For the Amendment to Section 5 Art 4 of the Constitution of the State of Texas, 319 against said Amendment 905, For the Amendment to Section 50 Art 3 of the Constitution of the State of Texas 435, against said Amendment 785+

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that the Prohibition carried by a majority of four votes, and that woman suffrage lost by a majority of 370 votes, and that to raise the Governor's Salary lost by a majority of 586 votes, and that the land measure lost by a majority of 350 votes.

On this the 9th day of June 1919 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of allowing Ambers Johnson and Bill Moulton County funds for their support

It appearing to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that said Ambers Johnson is unable to support himself and that he is allowed the sum of \$6.00 per month, and that the said Bill Moulton is unable to support himself and is allowed the sum of \$7.50 per month. Said sums of money to be paid monthly out of the General County fund of Titus County, Texas.
