On this the 18th day of June 1919 came on to be considered ^{by the Commissioners Court of Titus Co. Texas} the matter of allowing W.M. Harkey the sum of \$50.00 to pay his expenses to Deepford Oklahoma for treatment.

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that the said W.M. Harkey is in destitute circumstances and that he is unable to support himself and is in need of help.

It is therefore ordered and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that W.M. Harkey be allowed the sum of Fifty Dollars to be paid out of the General County Fund of Titus County, Texas.
