

Be it remembered that on this the 7th day of July, 1919 there was held a special term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the following members present to wit: J. O. Abbott, County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. M. King, J. B. Brown and W. A. Lee, Commissioners, W. W. Smith, Sheriff, and O. J. Neugeart, Clerk, where came on to be considered by the Court the matter of equalizing the taxes for Titus Co. Texas.
