M. A. Penn Resigned } July, 14th 1919

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the resignation of M. A. Penn as Superintendent of Cattle dipping in Commissioners Precinct # 7 of Titus County, Texas. The Court is of the opinion that said resignation should be in all things accepted.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Tex. that said resignation be in all things accepted.

Public Weigher's } July 14, 1919,
Bond Approved }

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the Official Bond of Denver Harbour as Public Weigher of Titus County, Texas. The Court after examining said bond finds same to be a good and sufficient bond. It is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that said bond is in all things approved.

H. G. Campbell Appointed } July, 14, 1919
Supt. Cattle dipping }

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, the application of H. G. Campbell asking to be appointed Superintendent of Cattle dipping in and for Commissioners Precinct # 2 of Titus County, Texas. The Court after considering said application is of the opinion

Contract with 3
 Farm Demonstrator revoked 3 July 14, 1919

County Commissioner T. B. Brown offered
 the following order to the Commissioners Court
 of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion
 that the same be passed by the Court, which
 motion was seconded by W. A. Lee, Commissioner.
 The order is as follows, to wit: It appears to
 the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas,
 that the contract made and entered into on the
 21st day of June 1918 between said Commissioners
 Court and W. B. Hathorn, wherein said Commissioners
 Court agreed to pay said W. B. Hathorn the sum of
 \$600.00 per year out of the General County Fund of
 Titus County, Texas for his services as County
 Farm Demonstrator for Titus County, should
 be withdrawn and revoked.

The County Judge of Titus County, presiding
 put the motion for a vote of the members
 of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas,
 with the request that as many of the mem-
 bers that favored the motion to vote "aye"
 and all opposed, to vote "no"

County Commissioner T. B. Brown, W. A. Lee,
 Wm. King and A. P. Smart voted "aye" and
 none voted "no" The County Judge declared
 the motion carried and the order
 passed
