

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a regular session at the Court house of said County on the 26th day of July, A.D. 1919, with the following members present to wit:

County Judge, Grubb, County Commissioner Smart, Lee, King and Brown, and County Clerk, C. Mergent, County Commissioner, Smart offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus Co. Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by the Court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, Lee, the order is as follows to wit:

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that heretofore on the 15th day of March A.D. 1919 at an election held under the terms of a special road law for Titus County, Texas, then in force, the following named persons were elected, rather nominated as Road Commissioners for said County, to serve with the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, in the matter of the expenditure of the proceeds of a \$1,000,000.00 bond issue, also voted at said election. It further appears that said road law was repealed and that another road law was enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas, which validated the said nomination of said persons and made it the duty of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, to appoint said persons so nominated as such Road Commissioners.

The said persons so nominated being as follows to wit:
 Ed L. McCreary, for Justice Precinct Number one
 W. V. Mason for Justice Precinct number three
 J. W. Barrett for Justice Precinct number eight
 J. W. Coney for Justice Precinct number four
 John Wilson for Justice Precinct number three
 H. L. Taylor for Justice Precinct number seven
 Al Miller for Justice Precinct number five
 M. A. Cunn for Justice Precinct number two.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus Co. Texas, that each and all of said persons as above named be and they are appointed, Road Commissioners for Titus County, Texas.

as provided and required by the Special local law now in force for Titus County, Texas.

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the request that as many as favored the motion would vote "aye" and those opposed would vote "no" County Commissioners Smart, Lee, King and Brown voted "aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Court continuing in session with the same members present, County Commissioner Smart offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas which was seconded by County Commissioner Brown. The order is as follows to wit:

It appears that Ed McCreary, W. Mason, J. W. Barnett, John Wilson, J. W. Coney, H. Taylor, Al Miller and M. A. Burr, the persons appointed by this Court as road Commissioners, have made and executed the bonds and taken the oath of office as required by law, and that each of the said Bonds are in proper form and are signed by good and sufficient sureties, which have been filed with this Court. It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Tex. that each and all of said bonds be and they are approved.

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion would vote "aye" and all those opposed would vote "no" County Commissioners, Smart, Lee, King and Brown voted "aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
