

Be it remembered that on this the 17th day of Sept. 1919 there was holden a Special Term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the following members present to wit:

J. H. Gable, County Judge, A. Smart, W. King, W. A. Lee and T. B. Brown, Commissioners and C. Neugeb, Clerk, Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

The Court took up for consideration the matter of approving the Tax Rolls for the year 1919.

Commissioner Smart offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Brown. The order is as follows, to wit:

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the Tax Rolls prepared by G. B. Dickson, Tax Assessor, for the year 1919, are in all things correct and that they should be approved. It further appears that the said G. B. Dickson has filed with this Court his account for assessing and preparing said rolls for the year 1919, which account for the sum of \$1032.<sup>12</sup> is correct and should be allowed out of the General County Fund of Titus County, Texas.

County Judge, Gable put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no". Commissioners, Smart, King, Lee and Brown voted "aye" and none voted "no".

County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
