Tabb, County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. King, W. Lee and T. B. Brown Commissioners, and C. Nugent, Clerk. Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas,

Mrs M. A. White allowed }  
Funds for Maintenance. }

Whereas on this the 13th day of Oct. 1919 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of allowing Mrs. M. A. White funds for her maintenance.

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that Mrs. M. A. White is at present receiving \$5.00 per month from Titus Co. and that said amount is not sufficient for her support and that said amount should be increased to \$10.00 per month.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that Mrs. M. A. White be allowed the sum of \$10.00 per month to be paid out of the General County Fund of Titus Co.

In the Matter of Discontinuing }  
the work of Tick Eradication }

On this the 13th day of Oct. 1919 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas the matter of discontinuing the work of tick eradication in Titus County, which Commissioner Smart made a motion, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Brown; that the work of tick eradication in Titus County, Texas be discontinued to take effect Nov. 1st, 1919.

County Judge J. W. Tabb put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and

those opposed to vote "No" Smart, Brown, King and Lee voted "aye" and none voted "no".  
County Judge Jacobs declared that the motion carried and the order passed.

JR. Scott appointed }

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that said bond be in all things approved.

Teague as Constable of Precinct # 8 of Titus County, Texas and O.M. the resignation of R. F. League be in all things  
accepted to take effect from this date, and  
the resignation of Om. Hegner be in all things  
accepted to take effect Oct. 17, 1919

motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no"

Commissioner Smart, King Brown and Lee voted  
"aye" and none voted "no" County Judge J. W. J. J.  
declared the motion carried and the order passed
