

Be it remembered that on this the 22nd day of Nov 1919, there was holden a special term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the following members present to wit: W. A. Lee, County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. A. Lee, G. B. Brown, Commissioners, and C. H. Neigunt, Clerk.

Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, where the following proceedings were had to wit:

Appointed Constable. }

On this the 22nd day of Nov. 1919 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the application of John Amerson asking to be appointed Constable of Precinct # 8 of Titus County, Texas. Commissioner Smart made a motion that said John Amerson be appointed Constable of Precinct # 8 Titus County, Texas to serve out the unexpired term of Mr. Teague, which motion was seconded by W. A. Lee, County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no" all members voted "aye".

Bond Approved }

On this the 22nd day of Nov. 1919, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, examined the official Bond of John Amerson, Constable of Precinct no. 8 Titus Co. Texas, Commissioner Smart made a motion that said official Bond be in all things approved, which motion was seconded by W. A. Lee County Judge put the motion with the request that as many of the members that favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no" Smart, Lee and Brown voted "aye", none voted "no".
