

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas met in a special session at the Court House of said County on Dec. 07th 1919, with the following members present to wit: Webb County Judge, Edmund F. B. Brown and others.

The following proceedings were had to wit: County Commissioner Smart offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, which was seconded by County Commissioner Lee, the order is as follows:

"Be it ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the permanent School funds of Titus County, Texas, to the amount of \$2000⁰⁰ be invested in School Bonds of Bessman School District # 4, of Titus County, Texas, and to the amount of \$2000⁰⁰ be invested in bond of Common School District No. 7, of Titus County, Texas.

County Judge put the motion with request

that those favoring the motion to vote "aye"
and those opposed to vote "no" County Commissioner
Brown, Lee Smart voted "aye" None voted "no"

County Judge declared the motion carried
and the order passed,
