In the matter of approving |  
quarterly Reports of Officers. | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the matter of examining the quarterly reports of various officers of Titus County. And the court after examining the quarterly Reports of the following named officers find them to be correct to wit:

It is ordered and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that the quarterly Reports of the above named officer and County Depository be in all things approved.

In the matter of levying |  
a tax for the year 1920. | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the matter of levying a tax upon the real and personal property of Titus County Texas for the year of 1920, and the court after due consideration set the tax rate for the year 1920 as follows to wit: General County fund 25¢ upon the \$100.00 valuation of real and personal property; Court House and Jail fund 15¢ upon the \$100.00 valuation of real and personal property; Road and Bridge fund 15¢ upon the \$100.00 valuation of real and personal property; Jury fund 15¢ upon the \$100.00 valuation of real and personal property. It is further ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that the tax rate upon real and personal property in the respective School Districts throughout Titus County shall remain as heretofore levied for the year 1920.

In the Matter of |  
Ex officio Salaries | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas the matter of allowing County Officers Ex Officio Salaries for the year 1920, and after due consideration the court is of the opinion the following named officers should be allowed the sums of money hereinafter specified to wit: W. W. Smith, Sheriff the sum of \$550.00 per year. J. W. Tabb, <sup>County Judge</sup> the sum of \$1050.00 per year. Ulman Brown, <sup>District Clerk</sup> the sum of \$550.00 per year. C.T. Neugent County Clerk the sum of \$400.00 per year as Ex Officio and the sum of \$200.00 per year for keeping Finance Ledger and Records.

It is ordered and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that the above mentioned sums of money be allowed to be paid quarterly out of the General County fund of Titus County Texas as required by law.

In the Matter of Employing a |  
Janitor. | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the matter of employing a Janitor for the year 1920, and the court after due consideration is of the opinion that Ben Corprew is a suitable person and should be employed. It is therefore ordered by the commissioners court of Titus County Texas that Ben Corprew be employed as Janitor and that he be paid the sum of \$35.00 per month out of the Court House and Jail Fund of Titus County Texas.

Haulin trash. | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920, it ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that Charley Feldmann be paid the sum of \$2.50 per month out of the Court House and Jail fund of Titus County Texas for hauling trash from the Court House.

In the Matter of Appointing a |

County Health Officer. | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the application of Dr. S. R. Crabtree asking that he be appointed County Health Officer for Titus County for the year 1920, and the Court after due consideration is of the opinion that the said Dr. Crabtree is a suitable person and should be appointed. It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that the said Dr. S. R. Crabtree be appointed County Health Officer for Titus County for the year 1920 and that he be paid for his services out of the General County fund upon bill presented by him as required by law.

In the Matter of making |

more room for County Clerk's Office. | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920 it is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that J. W. Tabb County Judge have a door cut in the wall of the County Court House between the County Clerk's office and the County Judge's Office and that the office now occupied/shall hereafter be occupied and used by the County Clerk and that the office now occupied by the District Clerk shall hereafter be occupied by the County Judge, and that the office now occupied by the County School Superintendent shall hereafter be occupied by the District Clerk and the County School Superintendent shall move his office up stairs to one of the Jury Rooms.

In the Matter of Appointing |

J. W. Tabb Purchasing Agent. | On this the 10th day of Feb. 1920 it is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that J. W. Tabb be appointed purchasing agent for Titus County for the year 1920 and that he have full authority and is hereby authorized to purchase supplies for Titus County as required by law and that he be paid the sum of \$32.00 per year out of the General County fund of Titus County Texas, said amount to be paid quarterly.
