

Be it remembered that on this the 12th day of April A.D. 1920 there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas at the Court House thereof in the City of Mt. Pleasant, with the following members present to wit: J. W. Tabb County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. K. King, T. B. Brown and W. A. Lee, Commissioners, C. T. Neugent Clerk. Court was opened by a proclamation by the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

In the matter of the
Resignation of Ben
Chapman as Constable.

April 12th., 1920.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the resignation of Ben Chapman as Constable of Precinct No. 3 of Titus County, when Commissioner Smart made a motion that said resignation be in all things accepted, which motion was seconded by Commissioner King. County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "no" Smart, King, Lee and Brown voted "Aye" County Judge declared the motion carried xxx

In the Matter of appointing
E. Cato Constable of Precinct
No. 3 of Titus County.

On this the 12th day of April 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the Application of E. Cato asking the Court to appoint him Constable of Precinct No. 3 of Titus County Texas, when Commissioner King made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Lee; that the said E. Cato be appointed Constable of said Precinct to fill out the unexpired term of Ben Chapman. County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no" Commissioner King, Lee, Smart and Brown voted "aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the matter of transferring
funds from jury fund to
Interest and Sinking Fund.

On this the 12th day of April 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the matter of transferring funds from the Jury fund to the Interest and Sinking fund of Titus County, when Commissioner Smart made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Brown; that the County Treasure of Titus County be authorized to transfer the sum of \$900.00 from the jury fund of Titus County to the Interest and Sinking fund of Titus County to pay Court House Bonds and interest. County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no" Commissioner Smart, Brown, Lee and King voted Aye. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of allowing
Tax Assessor Fees for
assessing Taxes.

On this the 12th day of April 1920 came on to be considered by the commissioners court of Titus County Texas the matter of allowing G. B. Dickson funds for assessing taxes, when Commissioner Smart made a motion which motion was seconded by Commissioner King; that G.B. Dickson be allowed the sum of \$250.00 for assessing taxes for Titus County for the year of 1920, said amount to be paid out of the General County Fund of Titus County Texas. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no. Commissioner Smart, King, Lee and Brown voted "aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of approving
the Official Bond of E. Gate.

On this the 12th day of April 1920 came on to be considered and examined the Official Bond of E. Gate as Constable of Precinct No. 3 of Titus County Texas, when Commissioner Smart made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner King; that said Official Bond be in all things approved. County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no" Commissioner Smart, Lee, King and Brown voted "aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Ellen Allman allowed Funds:

On this the 12th day of April 1920 came on to be considered by the commissioners court of Titus County the matter of allowing Ellen Allman funds for her support, when Commissioner Smart made a motion, which motion was seconded by King; that the said Ellen Allman be allowed the sum of \$5.00 per month in addition to what she is now receiving from Titus Co. making a total of \$15.00 per month to be paid out of the Gen. Co., fund of Titus County, Motion put; Smart, King, Lee and Brown voted "aye. County Judge declared the motion carried
