

Be it remembered that on this the 19th., day of April A.D. 1920 there was begun and holden a Special Term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas at the Court House thereof in the City of Mt. Pleasant, with the following members present to wit: J. W. Tabb, County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. M. King, T. B. Brown and W. A. Lee, Commissioners, and C. T. Neugent, Clerk.

Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas when the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the Matter of Approving  
the Annual Report of Tax Col.

1920

On this the 19th. day of April 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas the Annual Report of J. M. Keith, Tax Collector of Titus County, when Commissioner Smart made a motion, which motion was seconded by Commissioner King; that the Annual Report of said J. M. Keith be in all things approved. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and all those opposed vote "no". Commissioner Smart, King, Lee and Brown voted "aye" none voted "no". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the matter of Appointing  
A. P. Smart to buy Parking  
Ground.

On this the 19th day of April 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the matter of Appointing A. P. Smart to <sup>buy</sup> parking ground, when W.M.King made a motion, which motion was seconded by T.B.Brown. The motion is as follows, to wit: That A. P. Smart be appointed to confer with the officials of the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas and purchase a suitable lot to be used for hitching and parking grounds; that said lot is to be paid for by the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas and Titus County, said City of Mt. Pleasant paying one-half the cost and Titus County one-half. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote aye and those opposed to vote no. all the members voted aye. the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of allowing  
Joe Ben Adams funds.

On this the 19th day of April 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas the matter of allowing Joe Ben Adams funds for his support, when Commissioner Smart made a motion that the said Ben Adams be allowed the sum of \$10.00 per month to be paid out of the General County fund of Titus County, Texas monthly for his support. said motion was seconded by Commissioner King. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye and those opposed to vote no. All members voted Aye. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

The above and foregoing minutes read and approved in open court this the 19th day of April A.D. 1920.
