Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present to wit: J. W. Tabb County Judge, A. P. Smart, T. B. Brown, W. A. Lee and W. M. King, Commissioners and C. T. Neugent, Clerk. Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Motion by Commissioner Smart that Titus County discontinue the dipping of live stock in Titus County so take effect May the 15th., 1920 and that there be no further appropriations out of the funds of Titus County, Texas to pay for said work after said date, seconded by Commissioner Brown. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "no" Commissioner Smart, King, Brown and Lee voted "Aye" none voted "No" The County Judge declared the Motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 10th day of May 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of

Titus County, Texas the matter of approving the Quarterly Reports of various County and Precinct Officers, when Commissioner Smart made a motion that the Quarterly Reports of the following named County and Precinct Officers be in all things approved, seconded by King. Motion put, Smart, King, Lee and Brown Voted "Aye". None voted "NO" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
