

Be it remembered this the 12th day of July A.D.1920 the commissioners Court of Titus County Texas meet in a regular session at the Court House in the town of Mt.Pleasant, Texas with the following members present: J.W.Tabb, County Judge, A.P.Smart, W.A.Lee, T.B. Brown and W.M.King, Commissioners, and C.T.Neugent, Clerk.

Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County Texas.

IN MATTER OF TICK ERADICATION

IN TITUS COUNTY TEXAS.

On this the 12th day of July A.D.1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, Texas the matter of taking up tick eradication for Titus County when Commissioner, Smart made a motion that the court take up the tick eradication work thru out Titus County, and that each county commissioner of said County employ a suitable man to look after and superintend the matter of cattle dipping in his respective commissioner precinct, which motion was seconded by commissioner King.

The County Judge put the motion to the members of the commissioners court of Titus County Texas with the request that as many favored the motion say Aye and those that oppose say No, the vote was as follows: Smart, aye, King Aye, Lee No, and Brown No., County Judge J.W. Tabb voted Aye. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF EMPLOYING
MEN TO SUPERINTEND CATTLE
DIPPING FOR TITUS COUNTY.

County Commissioner Smart offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by said court, which motion was seconded by Commissioner King.

Whereas on this day the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, directed that each County Commissioner of said county employ a suitable man to superintend cattle dipping in their respective Precincts.

And whereas, Commissioner Smart has employed Bob Slayton to superintend and supervise the dipping of cattle in Commissioners Precinct No. 1., of Titus County, Texas., and that Commissioner Lee has employed H. G. Campbell to superintend and supervise cattle dipping in Commissioners Precinct No. 2 of Titus County, Texas, and Commissioner King has employe d T. T. Polk to superintend and supervise cattle dipping in commissioners Precinct No. 3 of Titus County Texas, and Commissioner Brown has employed W. L. Gauntt to superintend and supervise cattle dipping in Commissioners Precinct No.4 of Titus County, Texas.

And whereas each of said commissioners has agreed to pay each of said employees \$100.00 per month for said services

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that each of said employments be and in all things ratified and confirmed, and that said salaries be paid upon bills presented by said employees as required by law.

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas with the request that as many favored the motion vote "Aye" and those oppose vote "No". Commissioner Smart voted "Aye". King ~~aye~~ Lee "No". Brown "No". County Judge, J.W.Tabb voted "Aye". The County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

The above and foregoing minutes read and approved, this the 12th day of July A.D.1920.
