Said amount to be paid out of the General County fund of Titus County on the 15th day of each month and to begin on the 15th day of July 1920, seconded by Commissioner King. Motion put. vote as follows: Smart "Aye" King "Aye" Brown "Aye" and Lee "Aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

King, Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 5., Ulman Brown, District Clark, T. B. Brown, Justice of the Peace, R. A. Lawler, Justice of the Peace, motion seconded by Commissioner King.

Motion put. vote as follows: Smart "Aye" King "Aye" Brown "Aye" Lee "Aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

THE TAX RATE FOR YEAR.

Jury fund 15 cents upon the \$100.00 valuation upon real and personal property.

Gourt House and Jail Fund 15 cents upon the \$100.00 valuation of real and personal property.

Special Road Fund \$1.70 upon the \$100.00 valuation of real and personal property.

All Special School Tax to remain as heretofore levied by the Commissioners Court of Titus

County, Texas, Motion asconded by Commissioner King, Motion put. vote as follows: Smart "Aye"

King "Aye" Frown "Aye" and Lee "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
