

BE IT REMEMBERED That on this the 18th day of Sept. 1920, the commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a Special Session at the Court house in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present to-wit: J.W.Tabb, County Judge, A.P.Smart, W.N.King T.E. Brown and W.A.Lee, Commissioners and C.T.Neugent Clerk.

Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus Co. Texas, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

Commissioner Smart made a motion that the resignation of Q.C.Gaddis Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County, Texas, be accepted. Seconded by Brown, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE"; and those opposed to vote "NO"; Commissioners, Smart, King, Brown and Lee voted "AYE"; The County Judge declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Smart made a motion that H.L.Thompson be appointed Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus Co. Texas, to fill out the unexpired term of Q.C.Gaddis Seconded by King The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE"; and those opposed to vote "NO"; Commissioners Smart, King, Brown, and Lee voted "AYE"; The County Judge declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Smart made a motion that the resignation of E.F.Cabaniss Justice of the Peace of precinct #7 of Titus County, Texas, be in all things accepted Seconded by King, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE"; and those opposed to vote "NO"; Commissioner Smart, King, Brown, and Lee voted "AYE"; The County Judge declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Brown made a motion that J.A.Brown be appointed Justice of the Peace of Precinct #7 of Titus Co. Texas, to fill out the unexpired term of E.F.Cabiness Seconded by Smart, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE"; and those opposed to vote "NO"; Commissioners Brown, Smart, King and Lee voted "AYE"; The Co. Judge declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Brown, made a motion that the official Bonds of H.L.Thompson as Constable of Precinct #1 of Titus County, Texas, and of J.A.Brown as Justice of the Peace of Precinct #7 of Titus County, Texas, be in all things approved.

Seconded by King The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE"; and those opposed to vote "NO"; Commissioner Brown, Smart, King and Lee voted "AYE"; The County Judge declared the motion carried.
