

BE IT REMEMBERED, That on this the 27th. day of Sept. 1920, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a Special Session at the Court House in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present to-wit:--

J.W.Tabb, County Judge, A.P.Smart, W.M.King, W.A.Lee and T.B.Brown, Commissioners and O.T.Neugent, County Clerk.

Court was opened by a Proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, where the following proceedings were had to-wit:-

Commissioner Smart made a motion that the Tax Rolls for Titus County, for the year 1920, as submitted by G.B.Dickson, Tax Assessor be in all things approved and that he be allowed the unpaid balance amounting to the sum of \$656.39 out of the General County fund of Titus County, Texas, for assessing taxes,

Seconded by Lee, The County Judge, put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE"; and those opposed to vote "NO"; Commissioners Smart Lee, King and Brown, voted "AYE";

The County Judge declared the motion carried.
