

BE IT REMEMBERED, That the Commissioners' Court of Titus Co. Texas, met in a regular session on the 11th day of Oct. 1920, with the following officers present to-wit:--

J.W.Tabb, County, Judge; A.P.Smart, W.A.Lee, T.B.Brown, and W.M.King Commissioners.
Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, whab the following proceedings were had to -wit:--

Commissioners Smart, made a motion that all acots be in all things allowed as presented. Seconded by King. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote " AYE"; and those opposed to vote " No "; All members voted " AYE"; The County Judge declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Smart made a motion that the petition of W.F.Agan, et als, asking the court to grant them a Public road be granted and that the following described road be made a public road, when said road has been opened up and cleared out by petitioners, Seconded by King, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court. Vote as follows: Smart " AYE"; King, " AYE"; Brown " AYE"; Lee, " AYE"; The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Commissioner Smart offered the following order to the Commissioners' Court of Titus Texas, and made a motion that same be passed by said court, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Brown, the order is as follows, to -wit:--
A. L. "It appears to the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, that Common School Districts Nos. 30 and 32 of Titus County, Texas, have authorized the issuance and sale of School house bonds and that same be offered to said Court for investment of the permanent School Fund of said County. IT IS THEREFORE, ordered that said bonds be purchased by the permanent School fund of Titus County, Texas, in such amounts as are presented and that the Clerk of this Court issue warrant against said fund, to pay for said bonds at their par value and accrued interest.

Motion put, Commissioners Smart, Lee, King and Brown voted " AYE";
Motion declared carried and order passed.
