

As it remembered that on this the 11th day of Nov. A.D. 1920 the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas met in a Special Session at the Court House of said County in Mt. Pleasant, with the following members present to wit: J. W. Tabb County Judge, A. P. Smart, W. M. King, T. B. Brown and W. A. Lee, Commissioners and G. T. Neugent, Clerk.

Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, when the following proceedings were had, to wit:

In the matter of canvassing
the Return of the General
Election.

November 11th., 1920.

On this day the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas canvassed the returns of the General Election held throughout Titus County on Nov. 2nd., 1920 and finds that each candidate received the respective number of votes set opposite their names which is of record in the Record of Election returns of Titus County, Texas. It is ordered and adjudged by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas that the candidates receiving the highest number of votes be declared elected to their respective offices for a term of two years.
