Commissioner Lee made a motion that Henry Allen be allowed the sum of \$30.00 per month out of the General County Fund of Titus County, Texas beginning October 15th., 1920 and on the 15th day of each month thereafter as directed by this court, seconded by Commissioner Smart, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no". Commissioner Smart, Lee, King and Brown voted "aye". The County Judge declared the Motion carried and the order passed,

In the Matter of Allowing
fees for holding General Election.

Commissioner Smart made a motion that all Judges and Clerks who held General Election on Nov. 2nd 1920 be allowed the sum of \$2.00 each and that the Presiding Judges be allowed the sum of \$2.00 each in addition for making returns of said election, seconded by King. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no". Commissioner Smart, Lee, King and Brown voted "aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried.
