

DECEMBER SPECIAL TERM, 1920.

Be it remembered that on this December, 1st, A.D., 1920, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a special session at the Court House, in the City of the Mount Pleasant, with the following members present, to-wit; J.W. Fabb, County Judge, I.P. Smart, W.M. King, W.A. Lee and T.B. Brown, Commissioners of said County, and C.T. Neugent, Clerk,

The Court was opened by a proclamation by the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, when the following proceeding were had to-wit;

Motion by Smart, that J.B. Sarrett, be allowed the sum of \$100.00, per month for the maintaining the graded roads in Titus County, beginning November, 1st, 1920, and he is hereby authorized to file accounts with the County Clerk for employed labor on said roads, and that the County Clerk is, as presented by said Sarrett, authorized to pay said accounts, out of the Automobile fund of Titus County, Texas, on the First day of each month hereafter; Seconded by T.B. Brown, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to Aye. and those vote opposed to vote No, Commissioner Smart, Brown, King and Lee voted Aye, The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
