

DECEMBER SPECIAL TERM OF 1920. DECEMBER 6th, 1920.

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas met in a special session at the Court House of said County on the 6th day of December, A.D.1920, with the following members present to wit; Dan M. Cook, County Judge, W.M.Edwards, W.A.Fleming, L.H.Olds and W.M.King, County Commissioners and Ulman Brown, County Clerk;

Court was opened by John J.Reeves, Sheriff, of Titus County, Texas.

Motion by Olds to approve report of J.C.Snodgrass, J.T.Barber, D.C.Harkrider, D.H.Snodgrass, F.M.White, Jury of View, of date Nov. 10th, 1920, by approved duly adopted and the road therein described be opened up and constructed by the Road Overseer seconded by Edwards, Motion put by County Judge, Edwards, Fleming, Old and King, voted "Aye", The County Judge declared the motion carried.

----- REPORT -----

We, J.C.Snodgrass, T.J.Barber, D.C.Harkrider, D.H.Snodgrass and F.M.White, as a Jury of view to lay out the public road herein described, hear objections of property owners, assess damages etc, beg to report to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that we took the oath of office required by law in such cases and gave notice in writing to each and every property owner owning land touched or crossed by said road to meet us at F.M.White's residence on the 18th day of November, A.D.1920, and make any and all objections and file claims for damages to and with us concerning the laying out of said road.

That on said day we met at the place fixed by said notice to hear objections and receive claims for damages as aforesaid and that none of such persons or any other person appeared or filed any claim for damages with us concerning said road- That we viewed said road as required by law and we found and so report to your Honorable body that there will be no damages resulting from laying out or building said road and that no person filed any claim with us for damages to any of said property or otherwise.

We viewed only laid out said road along the line described as follows, to-wit; BEGINNING on Cason road about 4 miles S.E. from Mt.Pleasant, Texas in Titus County, Texas, and thence a general South course according to the field notes given in petition of freeholders to commissioners court of Titus County, Texas, to the point or place described in said petition as the terminus of said road.

Said line is the best ground upon which to locate said road and will be a location which will cost less to build and maintain a road.

We, therefore, make this our report and pray that it be approved and, if under the law, it is necessary that we be discharged.

No.2. Motion by Edwards, Commissioner, that W.A. Fleming, Commissioner, to repair a Bridge out close to Mr. S.A. Newman, Second by Olds. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the Commissioners of said Court, of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye", and those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner, Fleming, Old, Edwards and King, Voted "Aye", The County Judge declared the Motion carried.

No.3. Motion by Edwards, Commissioner, that County Judge D.M. Cook, and Seb F. Caldwell, prepare a statement of the indebtedness of the County and present same at the next regular term of this Court Second by Commissioner Fleming, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner Edwards, Old, Fleming and King, voted "Aye", The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

No.4. Motion by Commissioner King that the County Judge of this County, employ a Janitor for \$40.00, per month to do the Janitor services at the Court House, Court House Toilet and Court House Yard, and that said Janitor shall be under the direction of the County Judge, Second by Commissioner Edwards, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner Old, King, Edwards and Fleming voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the Motion carried and the order passed.

No.5. Motion by King that County Attorney Allen Reed, filed Suit on the Convict Bond of Raymond Riddle against the Sureties on said Bond, Second by Old The Commissioner King Old, Edwards and Fleming Voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the Motion carried and the order be entered of minutes of this Court,

Commissioner Court in session, this the 6th day of Dec. 1920, It is ordered adjudged and decreed by the court that Allen Reed County Attorney, proceed to file suit on the Raymond Riddle Convict Bond for the collection of the same, in the name of Titus County and the Commissioners Court.

No.6. Motion by King that the official bond of Elmer Cato, as Constable of Pre. No. 2. in and for Titus County, Texas, be approved, motion second by Commissioner Edwards, County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Edwards, Old and Fleming voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the Motion carried.

No.7. Motion by Fleming that the County Judge of this County, be the purchasing agent second by Commissioner Edwards, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No", Commissioner King, Fleming, Old and Edwards voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

No.8. Motion by King that the account of J.P. Wilson, be allowed, for the carpenter work and material on the floor of the county Clerk's office for the sum of \$48.40, second by Edwards, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners

Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" these oppose to vote "No" Commissioner Old, Fleming, Edwards and King voted "Aye", The County Judge declared the motion carried.

No. 9. Motion by Commissioner Fleming that the books of Titus County, Texas, be audited, seconded by D.H. Old, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Commissioner Court, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner Old, Fleming and Edwards voted "Aye" and Commissioner King, voted "No" for the present, the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
