

DECEMBER REGULAR TERM. 1920.

BE IT REMEMBERED That the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a regular session on the 13th day of December, , A.D.,1920, at the Court House of Titus County, Texas, with the following members present to wit; County Judge, Dan M. Cook, County Commissioners, L.W.Old, W.A.Fleming, W.M.Edwards and W.M.King. and County Clerk, Ulman Brown.

Court having been opened by proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, County Commissioner W.M.King, made a motion that \$1000.00, be paid out of the funds of Titus County, to supplement the funds of the U.S. Department of Agriculture and A. and M College of Texas in paying the salary of the County Agent of the Farmers' Cooperative Demonstration work in Titus County, seconded by Commissioner W.M.Edwards, and the County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court with the request that as many as favor the motion to vote "Aye", and those oppose to vote "No", and all Commissioners King, Fleming, Edwards and Old voted "Aye", and the County Judge declared the motion carried and order passed, as follows ;

The State of Texas,
County of Titus .

The Commissioners' Court of Titus County in session Dec. 13, 1920 made and entered of record the following order: Under and by authority of Chapter 62 of the General law of the Texas 22nd, Legislature, 1911:--

That the sum of \$1000.00 Dollars be and hereby is appropriated and set aside annually out of the funds of Titus County To supplement the funds of the U.S. Department of Agriculture and A and M College of Texas in paying the salary of the County Agent of the Farmers' Cooperative Demonstration Work in Titus County.

said sum shall be paid out upon receipt of vouchers drawn and approved by the Department's Authorized Agent and become available on or after the 1 day of January 1921. And as long as the U S Department of Agriculture will conduct said work in said county, this for 1 year.

In event said court finds it necessary to revoke the above order; the order dis-

continuing same shall be passed only during the month of _____ or _____, which time will be near the close of a season and the year's work; otherwise this order shall remain in full force from year to year.

Motion by W.M.King, that the accounts and entered in Minutes of Accounts allowed in Vol. 2, pages 66 and 67, from claim No. 1 to 39, be allowed seconded by Edwards, the County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners with the request that as many as favored to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No", King, Edwards, Fleming and Old voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the Motion carried and ordered the County Clerk to draw warrants for same.

In the Matter of Approving # December, 18th, A.D., 1920.
the Report of Tax Collector. #

On this the 18th day of December, 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioner Court of Titus County, Texas the Report of J.M.Keith, Tax Collector of Titus County, Texas, when Commissioner King made a motion, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Edwards; that the Report of said J.M.Keith be in all things approved. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner King, Edwards, Fleming and Old voted "Aye", none voted "No". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Approving the
Reports of Sheriff and Justice of
Peace Pre. No. 1.

On this the 18th day of December, 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioner Court of Titus County, Texas the Reports of W.W.Smith, Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, and L.B.Roach, Justice of the Peace of Pre. No. 1. Titus County, Texas, when Commissioner King made a motion, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Edwards; that the Reports of said W.W.Smith and L.B.Roach be in all things approved. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner King, Edwards, Fleming and old voted "Aye" none voted "No". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of allowing
Pauper funds.

Commissioner King made a motion that the following names be allowed the sums of money out of the General County Fund of Titus County, Texas, to be paid the First of every month as follows, to-wit; Lillie Davidson, \$10.00, per month, Jack Harris, \$12.50, per month; Major Fulton, \$7.00, per month, Jim Moore, \$5.00, per month, Mary Fulce, \$5.00, per month, Willie Mckee, \$8.00, per month, Marshall Jones, \$5.00, per month, John Smith, \$7.00, per month, Ellen Allman, \$15.00, per month, Easter Oliver, \$6.00, per month, Louis Oliver, \$4.00 per month, Mrs. M.A.White, \$10.00, per month, And Ambros Johnson, \$6.00, per month, as directed by this court, seconded by Old. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner King, Old, Fleming and Edwards, voted "aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and order passed.

Commissioner Old made a motion that the County Clerk of Titus County, be given the authority to sell one Oliver Typewriter No. 5 that belongs to said county said Typewriter have been in use for the past 7 years in County Clerk's office, for the best price obtainable, Seconded by King, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No" Commissioners, King, Old, Fleming and Edwards voted "Aye" no body voted "No" the County Judge declared the motion carried and order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF INDEX
TO DEED RECORD AND PRO-
BATE RECORDS.

It appearing to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the letter "A" in the direct and Reverse Index to Deed records need to be made new and that about 7 pages in said Index needs to be made new, and that the Probate Index needs to be copied and revised, and a motion were made by Edwards, Commissioner, that the County Clerk of Titus County, Texas, be allowed the sum of \$75.00, to be paid out of the General County Fund for payment of this work, seconded by Old, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court, with the request that those favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No", Commissioners Old, King, Edwards and Fleming voted "Aye" no votes for "No" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
