

BEYOND REMEMBERED that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a special session, at the Court House of Titus County, Texas, in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on the 5th day of January A.D. 1921 with the following members present, to-wit: Dan M. Cook, County Judge, W.M. Edwards, W.A. Fleming, W.M. King and L.H. Olds, County Commissioners and Ulman Brown, County Clerk.

Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas. County Commissioner Edwards, offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by the Court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner Fleming. The order is as follows, to-wit:

* It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that it, heretofore on the 18th day of December AD 1920, by its order passed and entered in its minutes, created special funds out of the Constitutional Taxing Power of Twenty Five Cents upon each and every One Hundred Dollars valuation of taxable property within Titus County, Texas, for the purpose of General Fund of said County and against the Constitutional taxing power of Fifteen cents against each and every one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property within said County for Road and Bridge for said County for the purpose of fixing a basis of payment for the existing indebtedness against each of said funds of said county as now existing according to claim register of said county and made appropriations out of each of said funds from taxes collected and to be collected for the year 1920 to special funds for the payment of the interest on the indebtedness against each said fund and a part of the principal thereof, as it would later be made to mature by this court, in the year 1921 and made tax levies against each of said funds, sufficient to pay such principal and interest as it would be made to mature in the year 1921 and future years until such indebtedness and the interest thereon should all mature. It further appears to the Court that it is for the best interests of Titus County, Texas, its citizens, taxpayers and creditors that all such indebtedness should be arranged and made bear interest at the rate of 7% per annum from date until paid, payable semi-annually and that the time of payment of said indebtedness should be made definite and certain by making it mature and become payable annually for 10 years, which is agreeable and satisfactory with the owners and holders of the current warrants evidencing such indebtedness, as hereinafter described, for the following reasons, to-wit: the County at this time because of more subjects matter for the expenditure of public funds and duties imposed upon the commissioners Court and the County, to expend such public moneys in excess of the power of the County, under the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, which govern and control such matter, to raise and procure money to provide for such subjects of expenditure, owes more money, as charges against each of said funds, than it will be possible, in the exercise of the legal and Constitutional taxing powers, to pay in the next three years. This results in rendering it uncertain when a large part of such indebtedness against each of said funds will ever be paid, although the same is the legal and binding obligation and debt of said County.

It further results in reducing the value of the current warrants of the County becoming reduced in value much below par, varying from Seventy to Eighty cents in the Dollar, aside from the fact that the County is unable to pay for its current needs in cash or with a warrant that is worth dollar for dollar, is resulting and will further result in the discount persons dealing with the county having to take on the warrants issued by the County for current expenses, being added to the price charged

the County for the various things it needs in its current affairs.

The situation on the whole requiring the County to pay from twenty to thirty per cent more for its current needs, which may be avoided by reducing the time of for the payment of said indebtedness against each of said funds to a definite amount each year for two years and paying interest, as aforesaid, on the same until the debt is liquidated and appropriate a part of each of said taxing powers to this purpose and thus clear the situation and leave the County a part of said taxing powers to provide current needs for each of them.

It further appears that, of the indebtedness of said County against its general fund, as aforesaid, which is now outstanding and unpaid, the FIRST NATIONAL BANK of Mt. Pleasant, Texas is the owner and holder of the current warrants of said County, evidencing the same, in the Aggregate sum of Thirty Four Thousand Eight Hundred Twelve and 79/100 Dollars and that said warrants so owned and held as shown by the claim register of Titus County, Texas, are described as follows, to-wit:
